

Racing in France with SportProtosCup.

The Crosslé 9S is eligible to race in the French SportProtosCup 2016 race series. Entries from Crosslé Racing Drivers' Club members will be most welcome.

The series is open to Sports Prototype cars (non aero), with engine capacity between 1300cc and 2000cc, using engines, mechanical parts, chassis design and materials of a type available prior to 31/12/1994.

Events are double headers, consisting of 30 mins practice and 2 x 25 mins races with no pitstop for driver change. Rules are quite relaxed, and tyre options are slicks and rain tyres.

Race entry fee is between € 550 and €650 per meeting, dependant upon the circuit. Series registration fee is €350 for the season or a one-off fee of €150 per race. AMB/MyLaps timing transponder is not supported, consequently, a Swiss/French transponder will be required.

2016 Fixture dates and circuits are listed below, together with mileage (one way) and travel time from Calais.

2/4 September: Nogaro 1026km/669m - 9 hrs 14 mins

23/25 September: Le Mans (Bugatti circuit) 431km/268m - 4 hrs 10 mins

14/16 October : Ledenon 993km/617m - 8hrs 40 mins
